I am requesting funding to widen U.S. Route 59 (US-59) in the upcoming surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor for this project is the Texas Department of Transportation and the project will expand US-59 in Victoria, TX (ZIP Code: 77905).

I ask that \$8 million be allocated to the project. The funding will be used to add two lanes for a four-lane divided highway.
