Dear Chair DeFazio and Ranking Member Graves:

I am requesting funding to widen Interstate Highway-37 (I-37) in the upcoming surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is the Texas Department of Transportation and the project will take place at the interchange of I-37/I-77 in Corpus Christi, TX (ZIP Code: 78410).

I ask that \$17.6 million be allocated to the project. The funding will be used to add two travel lanes northbound on I-37 and an additional lane southbound.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits: improved safety, improved mobility, and reduced traffic congestion. With traffic along I-37 expected to increase 53% by 2040, it is critical that this project is completed.
