I am requesting funding to widen U.S. Route 77 (US-77) in the upcoming surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor for this project is the Texas Department of Transportation and the project will expand US-77 in Victoria, TX (ZIP Code: 77905).

I ask that \$20 million be allocated to the project. The funding will be used to add two lanes for a four-lane divided highway.
